

# IB Results 2015

This year's International Baccalaureate Diploma results were outstanding, with an average score of 38 points out of a maximum of 45 (versus the Diploma average of 30) with one candidate scoring 44 out of 45 points. Two thirds of the cohort scored 38 points or higher, at a level equivalent to or exceeding the Oxford and Cambridge conditional offer range. An average points score at this level means that we are, once again, among the best

schools in the world for the IB Diploma.

This year's IB Diploma students have gained places on highly competitive courses at universities including Oxford, Edinburgh, Bristol and Warwick.

Abbey School became an IB World School in 2008, and since then has achieved world-class results every year.
