## IB Results 2016

This year's International Baccalaureate Diploma results were outstanding, with an average score of 39 points out of a maximum of 45 (versus the Diploma average of 30 ) with one candidate scoring 45 out of 45 points. More than two thirds of the cohort scored 38 points or higher, at a level equivalent to or exceeding the Oxford and Cambridge conditional offer range. An average points score at this level means that we are, once again, among the best schools in the world for the IB Diploma.
